Dear friends,

Not long ago, someone asked me a direct and honest question: "Is Congregation Shaarie Torah pro-Israel? Zionist?"

At first, I almost responded reflexively — "Of course we are!" After all, we have:

- · The Israeli flag standing on our bimah.
- · A weekly prayer for the State of Israel.
- · A special prayer for Israel in a time of war, offered every Shabbat.
- · A Shabbat where we read aloud the names of hostages still held in Gaza.
- · "Bring Them Home" signs on our digital display.

These acts speak to a deep connection. But I paused. Because for the person who asked, it wasn't obvious. And that reminded me: sometimes the things that feel clearest to us deserve to be spoken aloud — with care and clarity — for others.

So, I want to offer a more thoughtful response, not only to the person who asked, but to all of you.

#### The Power - and Complexity - of Words

Let's begin with language.

**"Zionism"** is a term that has carried many meanings over time. At its core, it refers to the aspiration of the Jewish people to return to our ancestral homeland and live as a free and sovereign people. Like many others during the global transformation from empires to modern nation-states, Jews longed for self-determination.

In 1948, that dream became reality with the founding of the State of Israel — a place of refuge, renewal, and resilience following centuries of persecution and loss. This is not a hypothetical or a hope. Israel is. And our relationship with her is not theoretical; it is lived and real.

Today, though, "Zionism" is often misunderstood — used in ways that don't always reflect its original intent. For some, it's a political label; for others, it's a term they've only encountered in accusation. It's okay to wrestle with the word. But we shouldn't lose sight of the values behind it: the Jewish people's right to live in safety, dignity, and peace in our historic homeland.

#### What Does It Mean to Be "Pro-Israel"?

This too can be a charged term. Sometimes people hear it as meaning "anti" someone else. But that's not who we are.

Our tradition calls us to love peace, pursue justice, and honor the divine image in every human being. We pray daily for peace — not only for our own people, but for all people. And at the same time, we take seriously our responsibility to care for our family — including the Jewish people in Israel.

That kind of care doesn't mean blind approval. Families disagree. Families argue. Families grieve together. You can love a country and still struggle with its politics. We do it here in America, and we do it with Israel too.

We affirm our connection to Israel not because we are indifferent to the suffering of others, but because we are committed to the well-being of all — and know we cannot abandon our own in the process. Loving Israel and loving our neighbors are not contradictory.

#### Our Connection Is Deep and Enduring

We face Jerusalem when we pray. We say "Next Year in Jerusalem" every Passover. Nearly half of the world's Jews live in the State of Israel.

The past and future of all Jews are intertwined.

At Congregation Shaarie Torah, we will continue to pray for Israel, to name and remember the hostages, to display our hopes publicly and visibly. And we will continue to pray — with open hearts — for a time when all who live in the land know safety, dignity, and peace.

We may not all agree on the right policies or the perfect words. But we share something deeper: a commitment to care. For the Jewish people. For our neighbors. For the stranger. For each other. That's what it means to be a community. That's what it means to be family.

#### Your Input is Needed to Help Shape the Next Version of CST's Constitution!\*

Over the past several years, Congregation Shaarie Torah's Board, Staff, and Clergy have recognized that our Constitution no longer accurately reflects the current realities in which we operate.

Beginning in mid-2024, the CST Board initiated a review of the Constitution with several goals in mind - some relatively simple, such as clarifying language and correcting grammar, and others more significant.

Notable updates include:

- · Building more openness and transparency into processes, such as nominations and elections of Board members.
- · Restructuring the membership and committee Articles to reflect both the current and future state of how our Congregation would like to operate.

We are now launching a four-month process for the Congregation\* to review, provide feedback, and vote on the proposed revisions to the Constitution:

- · Sunday, May 4th, 1pm In-person Town Hall Discussion at CST
- · July/August, TBD, as needed Virtual Town Hall Discussion
- $\cdot$  Sunday, September 7th Congregational Vote on the Constitution Final Version, Inperson at CST

# Teaching for Shavuot: Standing Together at Sinai

Shavuot is the holiday we might not see coming. There's no matzah to stockpile, no sukkah to build, no shofar to sound. It arrives quietly, seven weeks after Pesach, as if the Torah is asking: "Are you still with me?"

And yet, Shavuot marks the central moment of our people's spiritual history: the giving of the Torah at Mount Sinai. Not just a Torah, but our Torah. Not just then, but now.

Our sages teach that every soul—past, present, and future—stood at Sinai. That means you were there. So was your grandmother. So was your great-grandchild, whether or not they've been born yet. We stood shoulder to shoulder, trembling with awe, saying together: Na'aseh v'nishma—we will do and we will understand.

In a world so full of fragmentation, the image of all of us standing together, hearing the same words in our own unique ways, feels especially powerful. The midrash even says that the Torah was heard in 70 languages, so that no one would be left out. Torah isn't just an ancient scroll—it's an invitation to be part of something larger than ourselves, to live with purpose, with compassion, and with a deep sense of belonging.

At Congregation Shaarie Torah, we embody Sinai every time we come together for learning, celebration, justice work, or simple kindness. When someone joins us for a class or helps with the kiddush or sings along at services—that's Torah too.

This Shavuot, as we read the Ten Commandments once again, let's imagine ourselves at the mountain, not just as individuals, but as a sacred community. Let's ask: What Torah is being revealed to me now? And how will I carry it forward?

We're excited to invite you to a meaningful evening of learning, food, and connection at our Tikkun Leil Shavuot on **Sunday, June 1**:

- 6:45 PM Inspiring presentations by our four Jewish Learning Experience (JLE) graduates, each sharing a piece of Torah rooted in their yearlong study of Israel.
- · **8:00 PM Blintz Break** Because no Torah experience is complete without a little cheesecake (or a lot).
- **8:30 PM Tisch & Shiur with Rabbi Oren:** "Looking Back: We made it to Sinai—but how did we get here?" A soulful, musical, and thoughtful gathering.

Then continue the celebration with services:

- · Monday, June 2 at 9:15 AM Virtual Shavuot Day 1 Service
- · Tuesday, June 3 at 9:15 AM In-Person/Hybrid Shavuot Day 2 Service, including Yizkor
