As the High Holy Days draw near and the gates of teshuvah begin to open, we find ourselves standing at a sacred crossroads: looking back on all that has brought us here, and peering ahead toward the road that leads to our shared future. That's why this year's theme is: "On the Road to Our Next 120: Get Your Kicks in 5786."

It's playful, yes. But it's also rooted—deeply—in who we are.

One hundred twenty years ago, so many of the pioneer Jewish families who came to the Pacific Northwest arrived here with little more than hope, grit, and a sense of purpose. Like the travelers of Route 66 who set out toward the western horizon, they brought with them memories of where they'd been and dreams of what could be. They planted seeds of Jewish life in new soil. They built homes, businesses, and—thank God—synagogues. They laid the foundation for the vibrant, multigenerational, values-driven community we now call Shaarie Torah.

And now it's our turn.

This year's High Holy Days are more than a season of personal reflection. They are a collective call to action. The phrase "get your kicks" evokes joy and forward movement, but it also reminds us: there's a journey ahead. One that requires our full participation. This year we are invited to:

- Reflect not only on the year that has past, our behaviors and actions but also the legacy we've inherited,
- Renew our commitment to make right the wrongs we can to do teshuvah with a full heart and solidify Jewish life and community, and
- Reimagine how you will be different, clearly articulate one small tangible way you want to be different act different feel different and you are a huge part in what Shaarie Torah will be for those who come after us.

Whether you've been part of this kehillah for decades or you're new to our Shul family, you're part of the story now. And this story doesn't write itself. We are the travelers. We are the builders. We are the inheritors and the dreamers.

In 5786, we begin again—not from scratch, but from strength.

So yes—get your kicks. Find joy in this sacred journey. Sing louder. Show up. Step in. Because we are truly on the road to our next 120. And we are traveling together.

Please wear white on Yom Kippur. It is a symbol of teshuvah. There is a midrash that asks, "how did God create the world? He wrapped Himself in a robe of light and it began to shine." This evocative image associates light with God's renewing, creative power. We each have our own appearance, beliefs, background. But together we can create a "great light" out of this community that we are building together. We hope you will choose to honor this beautiful tradition.


