

When I think back to this year's Rosh HaShanah and Yom Kippur, I can still feel it — the joy, the energy, the hum of voices filling our sanctuary. Over 300 of us came together to pray, to reflect, and to dream. What a gift to see our community so alive, so full of heart.

During those days, I reminded us that our tradition warns against living year after year with the same hopes, the same promises, the same "someday." Because "someday" too easily becomes "never." On Kol Nidre night, I shared a little story — you might remember it:

Every year since their wedding, Saul and Miriam went to the state fair. Every year they saw the same offer for helicopter rides. Each time, Saul said, "I sure would like to ride that helicopter!" And each time, Miriam replied, "But Saul, it's \$50! And \$50 is \$50!"

Decades passed. Saul was 87 when he finally said, "Miriam, this might be my last chance!" But again, she answered, "It's \$50! And \$50 is \$50!"

The pilot overheard them and said, "Tell you what — I'll take you for free if you can stay silent the whole ride."

Up they went — loops, dives, spins — but not a peep! When they landed, the pilot said, "Wow, you didn't say a word!"

Saul smiled and said, "Well, I was going to say something when Miriam fell out... but \$50 is \$50."

It's funny — and a little sad. Because the only thing more tragic than Saul and Miriam's helicopter ride is how many of us spend year after year dreaming of change... but never taking the ride.

The High Holy Days are our annual helicopter ride — the moment that shakes us awake. They remind us that life is fragile, time is precious, and transformation is always possible.

Rosh HaShanah asks: Who do you want to be? Yom Kippur asks: What's holding you back?

And Sukkot says: **Now take that growth out into the world.**

The Shaarie Torah Cemetery, nestled within an unassuming neighborhood in far SE Portland/inner-Milwaukie, has a long and storied history, which many people may not know.

In 1904, when the congregation was originally incorporated, it was known formally as the Portland Hebrew Sick Benefit Association. In 1918, supplementary articles of incorporation changed the name to Congregation Sharai Thorah. The current spelling of our name didn't come about until 1956.

The parcel of land in what was then known as Errol Heights (later the Brentwood-Darlington neighborhood) was purchased by Joseph Nudelman in November of 1905, although our records show a few burials earlier that year. In fact, at the time of purchase, there was already a single non-Jewish burial on the grounds.

Thanks to volunteers at the archives of Oregon Jewish Museum-Center for Holocaust Education, documents were unearthed that shed light on this existing burial. Samuel Huffman died on October 18, 1904. According to the archives and interviews with his descendants, his family lived way out near what is now Estacada. They were devout members of the Disciples of Christ Church, where Mr. Huffman's father was a minister of that denomination. Most family members are buried in the local Garfield town cemetery. How and why Mr. Huffman came to buried at what is now Shaarie Torah Cemetery is a mystery. In 1904 it was a VERY long way to take a body, almost surely by wagon and perhaps via ferry, to reach the cemetery site. Mr. Huffman's grave is located in the West section, row A, plot 1.

For much of the 20th century, the West and Center sections were the primary burial sites. The East section (just North and West of the chapel) gained popularity starting in the mid-1960s. Today it's hard to find any plots in those sections that aren't already reserved or occupied. Indeed, the headstones are set check to jowl throughout these older sections with little breaks of grass in between rows. Lack of available space and increasing demand led to the development of the South section in the early 1990s. This is the section directly adjacent to the parking lot, notable for its lush green lawn and occasional fruit trees. Many years there is even a small pumpkin patch, planted by Bill Schaeffler, our beloved Caretaker, who retired in 2024 after over 30 years. Bill still lives on the property and keeps an eye on things. You may see him around when you visit.

The Cemetery Committee oversees decision-making regarding policies, pricing and the annual operating budget. Currently chaired by Steph Kotkins, the committee is comprised of both longtime and newer CST members. They share an abiding commitment to uphold the forever promises made to the families whose beloved departed rest within our gates. Landscaping and maintenance are among their highest priorities, as they keenly understand that poorly tended grounds will be the number one complaint from visitors. A 2018 policy change eliminated plot curbing for future burials (except for existing double plots). This has made mowing and trimming around headstones much easier and more efficient. At the same time, plantings on graves were removed for upkeep purposes, unless the family was committed to tending to them personally. In the years since, sod has been systematically laid area by area to blanket the graves entirely with grass.

### **CELEBRATING OUR HISTORIC CEMETERY CONTINUED**

The most recent addition to the cemetery is the Ohavei Yisrael section, directly in front of the Southern parking area and designated by a living wall of growing hedges. Approved by congregational vote in 2023, this area allows for burial of Jews and their non-Jewish family members (spouse/partner, child, sibling, parent). The hedge provides the required separation from the general burial areas, effectively creating a different cemetery entirely, in accordance with halakha. Rabbi Oren worked closely with the Cemetery and Ritual Committees to ensure proper measures were taken in planning this. While there haven't been any Ohavei Yisrael burials yet, there are reservations by interfaith family members, reflecting the changes in today's Jewish community.

Burial in the cemetery is not limited to Shaarie Torah members. Many non-members have relatives buried there and want to be close by. While members in good standing are entitled to a plot gratis after a certain number of years, non-members may purchase plots at a rate within current industry standards. All burials also incur a set fee towards the Perpetual Care Endowment Fund, to ensure the cemetery is cared for always.

The Cemetery Fund is the most selected of all the tribute funds for yahrzeit donations, which helps support operations. Maintenance and upkeep are year-round costs, regardless of the number of burials. Grounds must be tended, equipment replaced and bills paid. As annual expenses continue to mount, and income is unreliable year by year, the additional money that comes in the form of donations makes a big impact. Recently a number of generous donors added to their regular giving with special gifts around the Kever Avot v'Imahot visitation day on September 28, between Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. Rabbi Oren visited with families and recited prayers graveside with more people this year than ever before.

In the coming months we'll be sharing more information about the Next 120 Year Campaign, which will include special giving opportunities towards growing the Cemetery Endowment Fund, ensuring our beautiful and historic cemetery will continue to be a place of tranquility and comfort for all generations to come. # BRINGING MORE LIGHT HOME THIS HANUKKAH

Hanukkah reminds us that even the smallest flame can brighten the darkest night. When the Maccabees lit the menorah with only one day's supply of oil, they acted with courage and hope—not certainty. Their story teaches us that when we choose to bring light, the world around us grows brighter too.

Each night as we light our candles, we can ask: Where in my life can I bring more light? Maybe it's kindness to a neighbor, honesty in a tough moment, or gratitude for someone who helps behind the scenes.

# At-Home Hanukkah Activity: "One More Light"

Before lighting candles on the first night, invite everyone in your household to share ways they can bring light to someone else during Hanukkah.

Write each idea on a slip of paper and place it beside your menorah—your own "oil for the next day."

Each evening after lighting and singing, choose one slip of paper at random and commit to act on it before the next lighting. By the eighth night, you'll have created eight ripples of light in our community.

In Downtown and Northwest Portland, the challenge is clear: too many of our neighbors face food insecurity, struggling to access the nourishment they need for themselves and their families. Economic disparities, unexpected hardships, and various barriers create a universal struggle for reliable access to nutritious food. It's a challenge we can't ignore, and it requires collective action to overcome.
