Tu B'Shvat: Roots, Renewal, and the Inner Tree

As we approach Tu B'Shvat, the "New Year for Trees," we are invited to reflect on growth, connection, and renewal. In Hasidic thought, a tree is a metaphor for the human soul. Just as a tree's roots reach deep into unseen waters to sustain its life above, so too must our inner life draw nourishment from hidden depths. The Hasidic masters teach: every person is like a tree planted by streams of water, called to bear fruit that enriches the world.

Eating the fruits of the land, especially those associated with Israel, reminds us that our spiritual fruits are grown through attention, intention, and connection. Each bite becomes an act of mindfulness: growth takes time, patience, and care, just as sap rises beneath the winter soil before new shoots appear.

Reflective Questions:

- What hidden "roots" in your life need more attention or nourishment?
- What acts of kindness, study, or prayer can you cultivate that will bear fruit in the months ahead?
- How can your personal growth contribute to the life and spirit of our CST community?

Tu B'Shvat Activities:

1. Mindful Fruit Tasting: Try a new fruit and savor each bite as an act of gratitude.
2. Plant a Tree or Seed: Symbolically or literally plant something that will grow over time.
3. Acts of Tikkun Olam: Perform one act of service this month in your home, synagogue, or neighborhood.
4. Personal Reflection: Choose one habit or spiritual practice to nourish and track it weekly.


